

Cat Dissection Cardiovascular System- Conclusion Questions

Conclusion Questions:

Other than the labels on the diagrams, all answers to conclusion questions will be typed.

1. Trace the diagram provided on to a separate piece of paper. Label the parts of the heart and the blood vessels, from Step 5. **Draw straight label lines and DO NOT cross your label lines.** To identify if the blood vessel is an artery or vein, use the location and shape of the blood vessel. **You will not be labeling the pulmonary trunk, pulmonary arteries, or pulmonary veins.** They are not in the picture. Color your arteries red and your veins blue. Color your atria one color and color your ventricles one color.
2. Create a table that lists the names and functions of each of the structures that have an * in Step 5. (There are 17 structures total- some structures, such as the 3 parts of the aorta will have the same function)
3. Draw a flow map of the path of blood through the heart starting from right atrium and ending in the right atrium. Do not forget to include the lungs and body. (There are 16 structures including the lungs and body)
