

# Anatomy Rules for Dissection

## Rules for Lab

1. When being instructed, STOP, LOOK, and LISTEN.
2. Goggles must be worn at ALL times. Even students not dissecting must wear goggles.
3. Gloves must be worn by the dissectors.
4. Absolutely no “messing” around in lab.
5. Students must stay at their lab table. Students may only leave their lab table with permission.
6. Absolutely no eating or drinking in the lab.
7. Treat specimens with respect. Any disrespectful treatment of a specimen will result in the student being removed from the dissection until a parent-teacher conference is had. The student will NOT receive any credit for the dissection days missed until the parent-teacher conference. The student will still take the lab practical.
8. Absolutely NO pictures of the specimen, unless authorized by teacher. Rule 6 consequences will apply.
9. When needing teacher assistance, students will place **ALL** tools onto tray. Students may not handle tools while teacher is instructing at the lab table.
10. If feeling ill, let teacher know immediately.

## Start of Lab Dissection

1. Prior to coming to lab, read and/or watch videos on lab dissection procedures. You may be asked to complete a handout requiring you to list procedure steps.
2. Obtain goggles for each member of group.
3. Put on gloves.
4. Each lab group is assigned a lab sink, dissecting tools, dissecting tray, preservative spray bottle, and lab manual.
5. Obtain your dissecting tray, dissecting tools, lab manual and preservative spray bottle.
6. Place paper towels over try to minimize clean up.
7. Depending on the specimen, you will either obtain specimen from teacher or obtain specimen from your period's designated bin.
8. Begin or continue with your dissection.

## Lab Clean Up

1. Each lab group is assigned a lab sink, dissecting tools, dissecting tray, preservative spray bottle and lab manual.
2. Secure the specimen. Depending on the specimen, you will either place specimen in bag, remove all air, seal bag and leave it at your lab table to be collected OR you will place specimen in bag, remove all air, twist top, fold and rubber band to close bag, and place specimen in your period's designated bin.
3. Wipe down and dry tray. May need to rinse if dirty. No specimen parts down the sink.
4. Wipe down and dry tools. May need to rinse if dirty.
5. Wipe down and dry area around your designated sink. **DO NOT THROW AWAY DRAIN TRAPS. THEY ARE TO BE EMPTIED**
6. All specimen parts that are not used must be disposed of in the trash can, NOT THE SINK.
7. Place tray to the left of your sink. Place tools on top of tray with case open. Place lab manual and spray bottle on top of tray.
8. Wipe down lab table.
9. Inspect area around lab table. Pick up any specimen parts off of the floor.
10. Throw away gloves.
11. Wash hands.
12. Put away goggles.
13. **NO GROUPS ARE DISMISSED UNTIL THEIR AREAS HAVE BEEN CHECKED BY THE INSTRUCTOR**

**ADDITIONAL RULES MAY BE ADDED DEPENDING ON THE DISSECTION.**
