

Student Instructions for "How to Complete Nearpod Lectures"

Students will be taking lecture notes at home by completing a Nearpod presentation in which my YouTube videos have been embedded.

At the end of each video will be a set of questions (multiple choice or free response) related to the video, a statement that allows me to check student understanding, and a place for students to upload their lecture notes, so that I can verify that they are doing their work at home.

Procedure for Completing Nearpod Lectures



1. Open Nearpod (Go to the App on an iOS or Go to nearpod.com)
2. Type in the session code. (Session codes are provided in class and on the class website)
3. Type in your name correctly. (Period #- Last Name, First Name)
(Other- Date and Time you started the Nearpod Presentation)

Ex. 1- Wildcat, Willy
11/21 @ 9:15PM

4. Read the Objectives and/or Essential Questions. These are things you will be able to do after watching the videos.
5. Read the Vocabulary to Focus On. These are important terms for this lecture.
6. Watch video and take notes. When writing your notes, include titles and headings or in an outline style to help you stay organized. For your notes, be sure to write your name largely and clearly across the top on the first line of your paper. On the line below, write the Chapter and Title of the lecture.
7. Answer the Follow-Up Questions to the video. Be sure you click "Send" after completing each question.
8. List all of the things that you did not understand and need clarification on. This will be used to guide in-class discussions. If you understood everything, type "I understood everything." **DO NOT LEAVE THIS BLANK.**
9. Upload your notes.



Procedure for uploading notes from an iOS.

If you are completing the Nearpod Lectures on an iOS, the following are the procedures for uploading your notes from your device.

1. On the slide in which you are to upload your notes is an icon  Tap the icon  and "Take a Picture" or "Choose an Image" from your camera roll. If you take a picture and it is the one you want to use, tap on "Use Photo." If it is not the picture you want to use, tap on "Retake."
2. Once you have a photo, tap "Send." Next, it will ask you "Do you want to send this drawing?"- YES or NO.



Procedure for uploading notes from an Android.

If you are using an Android device, you will have had to open up a browser to complete the Nearpod Lectures because there is no Nearpod App for Android.

1. On the slide in which you are to upload your notes is an icon  . Tap the icon  and "Take a Picture" or "Choose Image" from your gallery. If you take a picture, your picture will appear. If it is the picture you want, tap "Send." If it is not, then retake the picture.

Procedure for uploading notes from an iOS or Android to your Computer

If you are using a computer to complete the Nearpod Lecture and you are uploading your picture from an iOS or Android device, the following are the procedures for uploading your notes from your device to your computer.

1. Take a picture of your notes using your device.
2. Open your Google Drive App and upload your picture from your phone into your Google Drive. In the Google Drive App, you have an option to "Upload Photos or Videos."
3. Select the photo from your camera roll or gallery and the image will automatically upload to your Google Drive.
4. Open Google Drive in your web browser on your computer, find your picture and download the picture on to your computer's desktop.
5. Go back to your Nearpod lecture. On the slide in which you are to upload your notes is an icon . Click on the icon  and select your photo from your desktop. Once your picture has been uploaded onto Nearpod, click send.
